Practice using escape sequences and displaying output.

1. Write a program that displays the ingredients for cake (shown below) in groups of six (6) lines at a time.
 - a. The first six lines should be displayed normally.
 - b. Lines 7-12 should be displayed indented one tab stop.
 - c. Lines 13-18 should be displayed indented two tab stops.
